

FUSD Event Promotion Policy

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that all events promoted through First Unitarian Society of Denver's (FUSD) website, newsletter, and social media channels align with our mission, values, and community commitments.

Events We Promote

- Events hosted or co-hosted by FUSD, its staff, or its committees and ministries.
- Congregational activities such as worship services, classes, discussion groups, social justice actions, music programs, RE events and community gatherings.
- Partner organization events when FUSD is a formal co-sponsor, participant, or has a clear role (e.g., leadership, volunteers, or presenters).
- Denominational events that align with Unitarian Universalist values (e.g., UUA, PRW, Side With Love, etc.).

Events We May Share Selectively

At the discretion of Mary/Rhonda and/or Rev. Mike, FUSD may share:

 Events hosted by aligned community organizations whose missions reflect FUSD's core ideals.

Events We Do Not Promote

Events without a clear connection to FUSD's mission or ministries.

Approval Process

- All event promotion requests should be submitted through the <u>Breeze event request</u> form.
- Final approval rests with Mary/Rhonda in consultation with the Rev. Mike.
- The team may edit event language or decline requests that do not meet these criteria.
